COURSES OFFERED TO INCOMING STUDENTS

The International Business Administration Bachelors programme is entirely taught in English. The programme starts twice per year, so every module is offered each semester. Exchange students can choose modules within this programme.

The Business Administration Masters is fully taught in English in Berlin and starts once a year. We recommend that you request a list of courses taught in English prior to nomination/application.

Furthermore, we offer additional modules taught in English from other study programmes and faculties. These courses vary from semester to semester; therefore, a finalised list of modules taught in English is provided to nominated students and partner universities prior to the semester start.

We require proof of sufficient proficiency for courses in English (English B2 CEFR).

If you wish to take courses taught in German, you must have proof of at least German level B2 (CEFR).

EXAMS, MARKS AND TRANSCRIPTS

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

The incoming students and their home institution will receive an official digital Transcript of Records after the semester.

This document will contain all courses and exam results at BSP Business and Law School.

EXAMS AND GRADING SYSTEM

The final exams take place during the examination period at the end of each semester. Students successfully pass the course if they receive a 4,0 and higher.

BSP Business and Law School uses the following grading system:

VISA & HEALTH INSURANCE

Non-EU/EEA citizens must apply for a visa for university studies before their departure to Germany. Further information is provided by the German Embassy or Consulate in your home country.

A visa application costs approximately €60 and may take one to three months to be processed.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Every person living in Germany is required to have health insurance. You have to provide proof of sufficient health insurance coverage for your enrolment.

ACCOMMODATION

You must arrange for accommodation yourself. We will give you specific information on how to find accommodation in Berlin and Hamburg closer to the semester start. We recommend to look for suitable accommodation as early as possible.
