COURSES OFFERED TO INCOMING STUDENTS

The Bachelor's Program "International Business Administration" is entirely taught in English. The program starts twice per year, therefore each modules takes place each semester. Exchange students can choose modules within this program.

Furthermore, we offer additional module taught in English from other study programs and faculties. These courses vary from semester to semester; therefore, we will hand out a finalized list of English taught modules prior to the semester start.

For English taught courses, proof of sufficient language proficiency (English B2 CEFR) is required.

If you wish to take part in German taught courses, you must have proof of at least German level B2 (CEFR).

EXAMS, GRADES AND TRANSCRIPTS

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

The Incoming students and their home institution will receive an official transcript of records electronically after the semester. This document will contain all courses and exam results at BSP Business and Law School.

EXAMS AND GRADING SYSTEM

The final exams take place during the examination period at the end of each semester. Students successfully pass the course if they receive a 4.0 and higher.

BSP Business and Law School uses the following grading system:

VISA & HEALTH INSURANCE

Non-EU/EEA citizens must apply for a visa for university studies before their departure to Germany. Further information is provided by the German Embassy or Consulate in your home country.

A visa application costs approximately € 60 and may take one to three months to be processed.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Every person living in Germany is required to have a health insurance. For the enrolment you have to provide a proof of sufficient health insurance coverage.
